


This Deed, made this 9th day of October 1886 between Thomas  
 Jones and Martha Jones his wife of the first part and Jacob W. Jones  
 of the second part. — Witnesseth that the said Thomas and Martha  
 Jones hereby grant and convey unto the said Jacob W. Jones in con-  
 sideration of love and affection for him as their son and in fur-  
 ther consideration of one dollar to them paid, with General War-  
 ranty, all that tract of land lying in Manassas District, —  
 Prince William County Virginia, lying on west side of road  
 from Manassas to Bradley School house and more specifically  
 described as follows: beginning at a stone a corner to Mrs.  
 Foster old place, now owned by Wedderburn, and also a corner  
 to Limstrong and running down a branch with Wedderburn  
 S  $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W 28 poles S  $37\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W 22 poles to a marked tree on the  
 West side of the branch S  $12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W 18 poles S  $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E 34 poles  
 S  $22^{\circ}$  W 7 poles, to a stone on the east side of the road from  
 Manassas to Bradley School House and on the bank of the  
 branch a corner to Mr. A. Clarke and running thence with  
 Clarke, and the centre of said road N  $46\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E 50  $\frac{1}{10}$  poles N  $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$   
 E 26 poles N  $26^{\circ}$  E 46 poles to a set stone in the road  
 thence leaving the road N  $86\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  W 60  $\frac{1}{10}$  poles to the begin-  
 ning. **Containing**, by a survey dated Aug: 10th  
 1860 twenty six acres and thirty five poles more or less  
 it being the land conveyed to the said Thomas Jones by  
 Samuel Walverton and wife by deed dated November 6th  
 1860 and recorded in Liber 26 page 100 of the records of  
 said County — To have and to hold unto him the said  
 Jacob W. Jones with all the appurtenances and privileges there-  
 unto belonging, to him and to his heirs and assigns forever.
