It is ordered that William Allen, Richard Stonnell and James Mackaboy being first sworn before a justice of the peace for that purpose, do view the ground along which the said road is proposed to be conducted & report to the court truly, the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as will to individuals as to the public if the said road shall be changed as proposed.
