VIRGINIA – At rules held in the Clerk’s Office of the County Court of Prince William County, on the 31 day of July, 1871 – Henry Love, plaintiff against Allen Howison, administrator of James M. A. Muschett, dec’d, Virginia M. Muschett, Robert Page, and Delia F. Page, defendants.

The object of this is to obtain a decree for the conveyance to the plaintiff of a brick Tavern House and lot, in the town of Dumfries, purchased by him of James M. A. Muschett, deceased, in his lifetime, and for which the purchase money has been fully paid. And the defendants, Virginia M. Muschett, Robert Page, Delia F. Page, his wife not having entered their appearance and it appearing from satisfactory evidence that they are not residents of this Commonwealth; It is ordered that they appear here within one month after due publication hereof, and do what is necessary to protect their interest. And that a copy of this order be published in the “Manassas Gazette” a newspaper published in this county, for four successive weeks and posted at the front door of the Court House in this county, at the next term of the said court -
