Be it remembered that on this 29th day of June 1867 A. N. Thomas and John S. stack of the said county came before me L. Cole a justice of the said county and severally acknowledged themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said A. N. Thomas the sum of one hundred dollars and the said John S. stark the sum of fifty dollars to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements if he the said A. N. Thomas shall make default in performance of the conditions underwritten the conditions of the above recognizance is such that whereas the above bond A.N/ Thomas has been arrested and this day brought before me L. Cole justice as aforesaid accused upon the oath of Susan A. Dean an unmarried white woman of being the father of a male bastard child, whereof she was delivered on the 17th day of January 1867 in the said county. Now, if the said A. N. Thomas shall make his personal appearance before the next county court aforesaid on the first court date of the next term thereof to abide the order of the said court touching the said accusation and shall not thence depart without the leave of the said court, then the above recognizance to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
