Commonwealth of Virginia vs Hughs

The Commonwealth of Virginia, To the sheriff of Prince William County – Greetings: You are hereby commanded to summon Hughs to appear before the Justices of our County Court of Prince William, at the Courthouse of the said County, on the first Monday in August next, to answer a presentment of the Grand Jury, made against him in the said court, on the 5th day of March 1834 "for unlawful gaming, to wit: Rowlet at the race field near Brentsville in the County of Prince William the same being a place of public resort within six months last past."

And have then there this writ. Witness, John Williams, Clerk of our said Court at the Court-house aforesaid, this 11th day of June 1834, and in the 58th year of our foundation.
