On or before the first day of January to wit: We promise and bind ourselves our heirs &c. to pay to Robert C. Weir his heirs or assigns the sum of one hundred and ten dollars for the hire of servant man Cornelius for the present year (1857) and we hereby bind ourselves our heirs &c. to furnish said servant with good summer and winter clothing, one pair shoes, one pair good boots and a hat and blanket. We also hereby bind ourselves our heirs &c. for and in consideration of services of servant woman Roseanna with four children to furnish said servant & children with good summer & winter clothing & blankets & 1 pair good shoes. As witness our hands and seals this 1st day of January 1857
