Historic Name: Nash House

Date or Period: ca. 1905

Original Use: Residence

Vicinity: Manassas

"A two-story, L-shaped, frame house with a hip roof, this structure has a large picture window and windows surrounding the front door. An oddity is the stair window, included to light the stair landing on the west side of the house. A two-story wing on the rear of the house, also with a hip roof, appears to be original. Interior features include a large stair hall; an open-well, three-flight, open-string stair; yellow pine floors; four panel doors; and oak mantels. C. E. Nash, who either bought or had this house constructed in the early 1900s, operated a hardware store in Manassas."
