State of Virginia – in Prince William County Court – March 1839

It having been satisfactorily proven to the court it is ordered to be certified that Thomas Bowne who was a captain in the Virginia Continental service in the revolutionary war, died intestate, about the year 1808, leaving only one child viz Elizabeth Bowne, who had previously to the death of her father intermarried with George Jansen of the city of New York. It is also certified that the said George Jansen died intestate in the year 1824 leaving the following children and only heirs at law viz, Thomas Bowne Jansen, Benjamin G. Jansen, Helen M. Jansen, and Mary S. Jansen, , now the wife of Thomas Powers. It is further certified that Thomas Bowne Jansen died intestate, unmarried & without issue in August 1838, and that his surviving brother and sisters before named, viz Benjamin G. & Helen M. Jansen, and Mary S. Powers are the only heirs at law of the aforenamed Captain Thomas Bowne.
