## Commonwealth of Virginia vs Lucien N. Fewell

On the eighth day of February 1868 personally appeared before me A. F. Dunn a Justice of the Peace in and for the county of Prince William, Thomas Jones of the said county personally known to me who being duly sworn according to law say: That on or about the 30<sup>th</sup> day of January 1868 I was assaulted by one Lucien N. Fewell of Manassas Va. Said Fewell striking me in a violent and angry manner, threatening that he "would skin me and my son and all the dammed Yankees about" And I have good reason to believe that my life and property are insecure, and from past experience I have no confidence that the civil authorities as at present constituted will punish the said Fewell, or attempt to restrain him from further outrages.
