Prince William County to wit

To H. M. Davis, constable of said county forasmuch as William Fraser has this day 20 July 1866 complained on oath before me Thos L. Selecman a justice of the said county that he is in fear that Bur Glasscock will do his property some private injury and has required surety of the peace of the said Bur Glasscock. I command you in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia forthwith to apprehend the said Bur Glasscock and bring him before me or some other justice of the said county to answer the said complaint.
