Be it remembered that on the 24th day of March 1898 Robert Blackwell & Levia Blackwell of the said county for and in behalf of Luther Blackwell, a minor, came before me W. M. Rice a Justice of the said County and acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of \$200 good and lawful money of the United States that is to say Robert Blackwell the sum of \$200 & Levia Blackwell the sum of \$200 to be made and levied of their several goods & chattels lands & tenements to the use of the said Commonwealth, if default shall be made in the performance of the conditions underwritten.

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above mentioned Luther Blackwell do and personally appear before the County Court of Prince William County on the first day of the next term thereof and shall then and there answer the said Commonwealth for a certain felony by him committed in feloniously shooting at with intent to kill one Addison Brown, within the said County, wherewith he the said Luther Blackwell stands charged, and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
