

EGYPT – 2705 Logmill Road

Date or Period: ca. 1800 and later

“Egypt is a two-story, gable-roofed, stone house that has five bays wide and two bays deep. There is a two-story, brick addition at the rear that is connected to the house by a two-story, frame solarium. The stonework in this house is its most outstanding feature. The gray color and the hard, even texture of the stones, which probably were quarried in the Bull Run Mountains, are characteristics that set it apart from the more commonly seen local red sandstone or brownstone.
