On the motion of Marshall B. Finch who produced the sheriffs receipt for the tax imposed by law, a license is granted him to keep an ordinary in this county until the next May term of this court, upon his entering into bond with security according to law, the court being satisfied that the said Finch is a man of good character & not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.

On the motion of Marshall B. Finch the court certifies he is a man of good character and that his store at Langyher's Mill in this county is a place fit & convenient to the neighborhood for the retail of ardent spirits.
