To W. W. Foley deputy constable, Whereas Dallas Murray of the said County has this day made complaint & information on oath before me J. P. Smith a Justice of the said Court that William C. Gray of the said county on the 1st day of August 1893 in said county did carry concealed weapon and shoot in the public highway.

These are therefore in the name of the Commonwealth to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me or some other justice of the said county the body of the said William C. Gray to answer the said complaint and be further dealt with according to law.
