Howson Hooe – Clerks Loose Papers Prince William County to wit

Whereas Howson Hooe of Fauquier County hath this day made information and complaint, on oath before me Lawrence Alexander a Justice of the Peace for this County of Prince William that this present day and various other times preceding divers goods of him the said Hooe to wit Wheat, Corn, Corn Meal, and Oats have been feloniously stolen, taken and carried away from the granaries of him the said Hooe in the County Prince William, and that he hath just cause to suspect, and doth suspect that William Carrico of Prince William County, did feloniously steal and take and carry away the same. There are therefore to command you, forthwith, to apprehend the said William T. Carrico and bring him before me or some other justice of the peace to answer the said information and complaint, and further to be dealt with according to law.
