"Mill Creek Farm, a one-and-a-half-story home, probably originated as a tenant farm on the nearby Evergreen Plantation. It was built in three stages: the first, a one-and-a-half-story, frame cottage with two rooms up and two rooms down; the second, an addition to the east end with one room up and one room down, and the third, an addition on the north side containing a kitchen with a bedroom above. The frame building on a stone foundation has a metal-and-asphalt-shingled, gabled roof. Old boxwood bushes, oak and walnut trees, and other landscape features, including some terracing, around the house."
