"Also on County 642 are the ruins of the LUTHER PEARSON PLACE, standing in a tangle of vines and underbrush. In the county records appear the names of Thomas Pearson and Captain Simon Pearson, who took up land in present Fairfax County in 1706 and in 1739 respectively. Many of the legended stones in the old burying ground are undecipherable, but inscriptions of the following people can be read:-----
