The undersigned citizens of Cabell County, Virginia respectfully petition your Excellency to request the proper authorities to have us transferred from the prison at this camp and placed under your own control at Wheeling rather than sent to the Military Prison at Sandusky, whither we have heard we would probably be sent in a short time, As Virginians we think it not unreasonable to ask that we should be under the control of the authorities of our own state so long as it may be thought necessary that we should be kept in confinement.
