To the Sheriff of Prince William County.... Greeting: You are hereby commanded to summon Thomas Lindsay (Tavern Keeper) to appear before the Justices of our County court of Prince William, at the Court-House in Dumfries, on the first Monday in November next, to answer a Presentment made by the Grand Jury against him at August term last for keeping a disorderly house and charging three shillings for a Supper contrary to the rate of allowance according to law at the tavern it being a house of entertainment & public resort in the County aforesaid within six months previous to said Presentment. And have then there this Writ –

WITNESS – Philip \bar{D} . Dawe, Clerk of said Court at the court-house, aforesaid, this 5^{th} day of September 1818, and in the 43th year of the Commonwealth.
