Commonwealth of Virginia vs Antonia Petria To B. N. Merchant, Deputized Constable

## Prince William County to Wit

For as much as Thos. O. Taylor of the said County, has this day made complaint on oath before me W. N. Rice a Justice of the said county that Antonia Petria in the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1897 in the said County of Prince William, did make an attack on his daughter Nancy Taylor & by threats to kill & murder did unlawfully and feloniously compel his daughter the said Nancy Taylor to give him the said twenty-five cents in silver coin currency of the United States of the value of twenty five cents and against the will of the said Nancy Taylor, feloniously did steal take & carry away.

These are therefore in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, the body of the said Antonia Petria, to answer the said complaint, and to be farther dealt with according to law. Given under my hand and seal this the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1897.
